My Father's House desperately needs a workshop / storage room. We do a lot of building / maintenance in our yard as well as in the community. Having the space to be set up and organized would be a great blessing! Jim teaches our teens as well as young men from the community skills from welding to carpentry of all types. This workshop will allow projects to be done with greater ease. The plan is to build it connected to the pool so the roof will serve as a pool deck. Projected date of this construction is June of 2006.

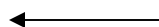

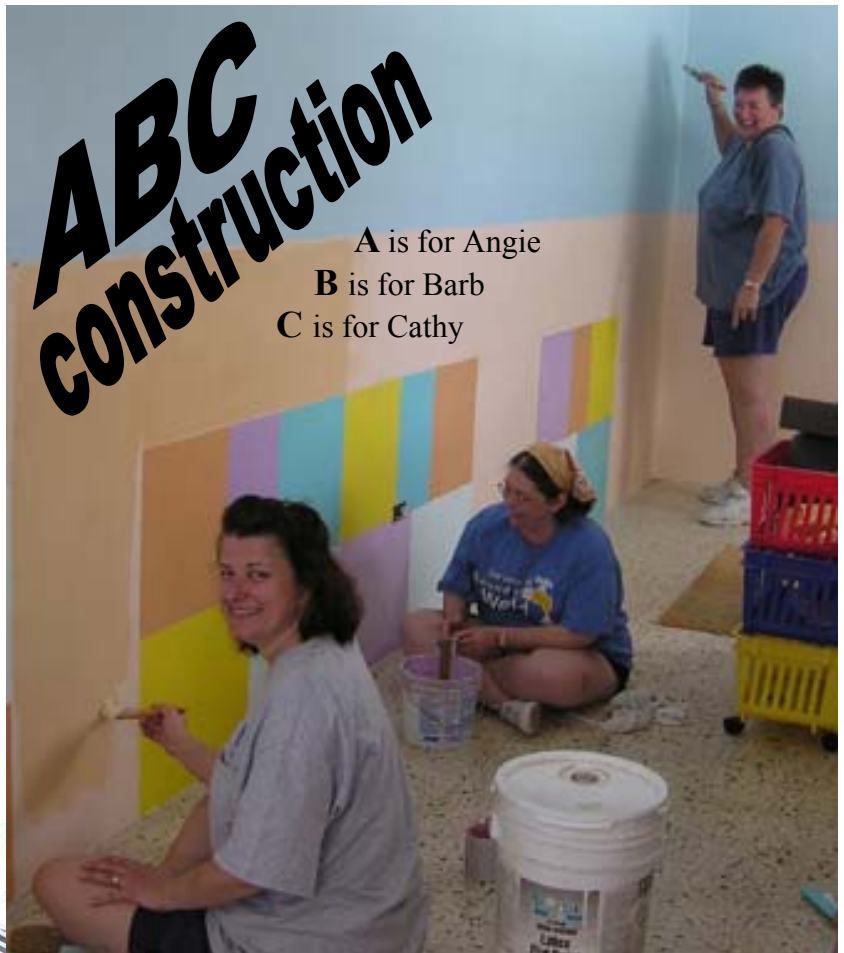

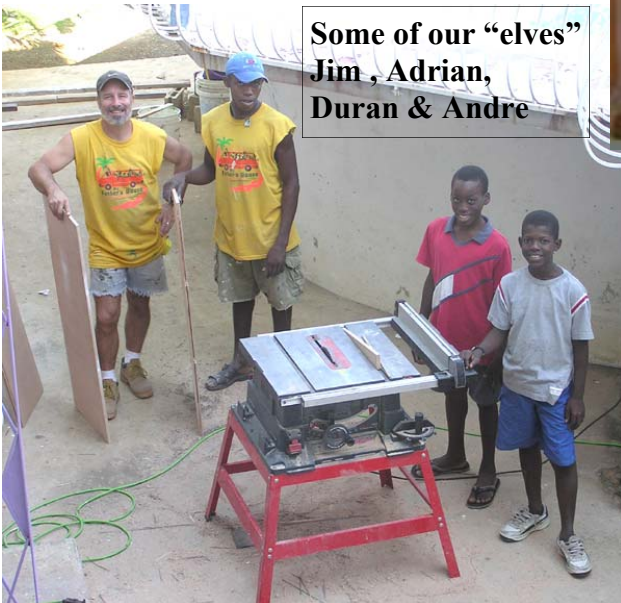

tion anyone can see each condo and visit the spaces designated for Barbie's shops, doctor office, school and many other business needed for a successful town.

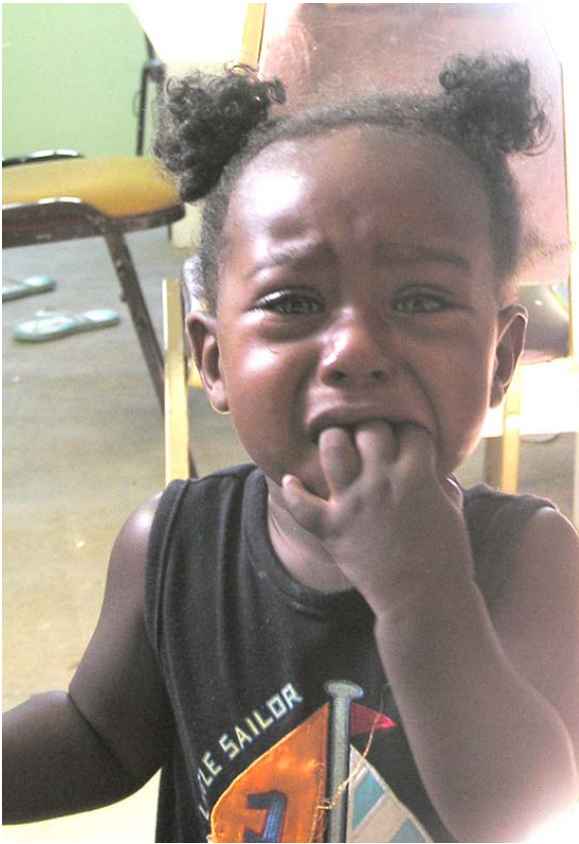

↙ The finished project as seen on Christmas morning ↘

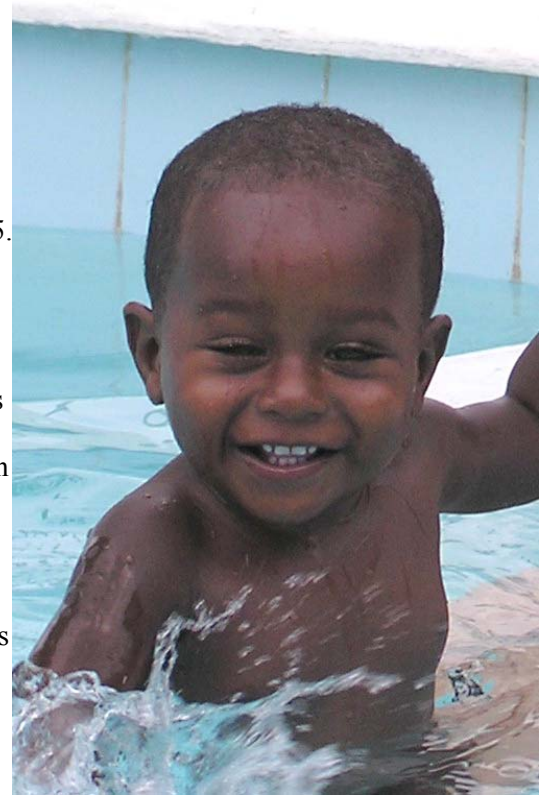
